Routers A router is a store-and-forward device Routers are connected to multiple networks On each network, looks just like another host A lot like a bridge/switch, except at the network layer Must be explicitly addressed (L2) by incoming frames Not at all like a switch, which is transparent Removes link-layer header, parses IP header
